Dear property owner:

Prairie Wind Transmission, LLC (Prairie Wind) filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission on February 28, 2011 seeking permission to construct a new high capacity electric transmission line. In its filing with the Commission, Prairie Wind proposed a route for this transmission line. Before, during and after the Commission's public hearing held on April 7, 2011, in Harper, Kansas, several members of the public proposed various modifications to Prairie Wind's proposed transmission line route. Our records indicate that you own property located within 1,000 feet of one of the alternative routes proposed by one or more landowners.

Because these landowner alternatives to Prairie Wind's proposed transmission line route have been proposed recently and could involve landowners who have not yet been involved in the transmission line routing process, Prairie Wind and the Commission have agreed that it is appropriate to solicit comments and answer questions from landowners who own property located within 1,000 feet of one of these landowner alternatives.

The Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 10 from noon until 2:00 PM at ICM, 310 North First Street, Colwich, Kansas 67030, to allow you to ask questions and testify before the Commission. The first half of the meeting will include opening comments by Prairie Wind as well as a question and answer period. At approximately 1:00 PM, those wishing to make a statement before the Commission will be able to do so.

If you are not able to attend the public hearing, the Commission has agreed to accept written public comments until 5:00 PM on Wednesday, May 11, 2011.
